



Leadership Program

Endowment Growth

Department: Undergraduate Programs

At the time undergraduate fees were first established, an endowment and an operating account were created to support undergraduate leadership programs. A portion of the fees collected are used to fund these accounts.

One percent of student fees collected are allocated as follows.

- One half of the amount collected is allocated to an operating account that can be used immediately to fund undergraduate leadership programs.
- The other half is added to an endowment which generates additional funds for the operating account.

Inception to date:

- The endowment has grown to over \$186K and has paid out \$33K in earnings.
- Between the endowment payout and the allocation to operating funds each year, almost \$160K has been spent on undergraduate leadership program activities since the inception of the program.
